In 24 months, NPC completed 1.2 million sq ft of construction, including the creation of three distinctive office buildings, the largest topped with a 300-kW solar array; a net zero-energy visitor reception center; reconstruction of the campus entrance; and construction of a 10-level parking garage for 1,700 vehicles. World-renowned architectural firms contributed signature designs, but collaboration and construction coordination also was in a class by itself. Despite the
